WHAT'S NEW IN REAL ESTATE

Rod to get costlier by Tk. 1,200 to Tk. **3,500** a tonne



Building a home, bridge, or undertaking any other construction project will become costlier from 1st February following yesterday's record hike in gas prices as steel and other construction materials are also set to become costlier. According to the government notification, large and medium industries that use gas must pay an additional 150% and 155% for gas. If the mills have captive power plants run by gas, they will have to pay 88% more bills. Presently, the price of a tonne of 60-grade rod stands at around Tk. 90,000, up from Tk. 54,000 two years ago. The government has hiked gas prices by up to 179%, eliminating subsidies to cut fiscal deficit, in hopes of securing \$4.5 billion loans from the International Monetary Fund, according to some businesses.
